### **Candace Eisner-Strick -**

**CS-1 Ten Things Mother Never Taught You** – Chances are, you're still doing the cast on, decreasing, and other techniques that your mother taught you umpteen years ago. No matter how long you've been knitting, you can still refine your techniques to make your knitting look neater and more professional. We will cover 10 valuable techniques: cable edge cast on, provisional cast on, one row buttonhole, spacing buttonholes, mattress stitch, 3 needle bind off, short row shoulder shaping, paired increases, paired decreases, delayed bind off. Level: All

**CS-2 The Case of the Vanishing Cable Needle** – We all know that those cable needles take off on us the first chance they get! They run between couch cushions, jump onto the floor of airplanes, and disappear every time they get the chance. Now you can let them run away and not care. Learn how to cable without them, and come away with this great technique, as well as a better understanding of cable construction. Level: Advanced Beginner

**CS-3 Chill Out Hybrid Shawl** - Knit a purely relaxing, beautifully fitting shawl without any hassle of reading patterns or charts. Use any weight yarn, any size needles, make it any size. Worked from the top down, this shawl incorporates easy shaping that makes it stay on your shoulders. You can finish it off in any number of different ways....bind off, easy crochet edge bind off, or knit a ruffly border. Level: Advanced Beginner

### **Betsy Hershberg**

**BH-1 Beaded Knitted Sampler**- Bead knitting is a great way to add interest and maybe even a little “bling” to your knitting. This class provides a thorough introduction to all that you need you need to know to begin adding beads to your projects, including methods which require pre-stringing and others which allow you to add beads as the spirit moves you! You'll complete the sampler in class from a supplied pattern so that with your sampler and written materials you will have a reference for future work. \$2 materials fee, payable to instructor. Level: Advanced Beginner

**BH-2 Beaded Bracelet - Knitted** - In this class you'll learn about all the tools and techniques you need to design and complete your own bead knitted bracelet or necklace. With the aid of a unique design template, students will make color choices for both beads and fiber and explore bead placement designs, the rules of bead stringing and chart reading. \$15 materials fee, payable to instructor. Level: Intermediate

**BH-3 Knitted, Beaded Beads** - Beads are often the basis for jewelry of all sorts. In this class, learn how to apply both old and new knitting techniques to the creation of two different types of beads: plain knitted and bead knitted, that can be used to create unique necklaces, bracelets and even earrings. \$15 materials fee, payable to instructor. Level: Intermediate

### Marji LaFreniere –

**MB-1: Lace Crochet** - Explore lace crochet! In class we will make a pretty lace circle that can be a small doily or sachet. Written directions will be provided or you can learn to work from charts. Must have basic crochet skills.

### Melissa Leapman –

**ML-1 Colorful Cables** – Savvy knitters know that cables add beautiful texture to knitted fabrics without much effort. Just imagine the awesome effects you can achieve by incorporating colorwork into them! In this hands-on workshop, discover several easy ways to make cables even more exciting—and fun—to knit. Level: Advanced Beginner

**ML-2 Mosaic Knitting: Colorful Knitting the Easy Way** - Do you like the look of intricate colorwork but hate the thought of all those bobbins and tangled up yarns? In this workshop, learn the in's and out's of this deceptively easy technique. Level: Advanced Beginner

**ML-3 Two Color Double Knitting** - With this fascinating knitting technique, both sides of the knitting appear to be stockinette stitch. In just a few fun hours, learn how to knit—and design!—these beautiful reversible fabrics. Level: Intermediate

### Deborah Newton –

**DN-1 Design** – This day-long workshop is for knitters and designers who want to either begin or refine their design process. Students can come with any level of expertise-- no design experience is required! We'll look at all kinds of visuals, talk about inspiration, discuss the difference between professional and personal designing, experiment with measuring and various methods of charting. We'll break down the design process, compare and analyze pattern stitches, learn some tips about illustrative drawing, do some swatching, and plan a pattern. You can go home with a sweater design (maybe two!) and the solid beginnings of YOUR OWN design process. Level: All

### Kristin Nicholas –

**KN-1 Embellishing Knitwear** – Do you love knitting colorful creations but Fair Isle or Intarsia techniques aren't quite your thing? Step into Kristin's world of embellishing knitwear with a needle and thread. The easy techniques you will learn will help add personality and panache to all your knitwear. And they are a whole lot of fun too! You'll learn duplicate stitch, chain stitch, French knots, lazy daisies, spider web, running stitch, and more. Kristin will share her helpful techniques to give your embroidery a professional look. When you're finished, you'll be able to decorate your own knitwear with fantastic flourishes that will make your work sparkle. Level: All

**KN-2 Fair Isle Sampler** – This adorable little project can be a child's scarf or a colorful draft stopper by the kitchen door. Create your own exciting colorways and patterns to explore fair isle knitting techniques. Learn how to choose colors that will complement each other and how to pick designs that will show them off! Level: Intermediate
