

Cashmere Sequential

Size: Approximately 6" wide x 48" long after washing.

Materials: Three skeins of Cardiff Cashmere Classic; 25g/approx. 120yds. Size 4 needles or size needed to get gauge.

Gauge: Approximately 6-6 ½ stitches = 1"

Directions:

Cast on 45 stitches, work for about 18 rows in K3, P3 rib as follows: Row 1: K3, P3, repeat across, ending with a K3 Row 2: P3, K3, repeat across, ending with a P3

Begin Pattern stitch:

This is a sequential knitting stitch, meaning that once you start the sequence, you just continue, rather than starting over at the beginning of the next row. Once you get used to doing this, it's easy to just keep going along. If you forget where you ended, just look at the end of the previous row and you can see where you need to pick up and continue.

Here's the sequence: K3, P1

For those of you who would rather see the rows written out, this is how that works out:

Row 1. K3, P1, repeat across row, ending with K1 Row 2. K2, P1, (K3, P1) repeat across row, ending with K2 Row 3: K1, P1, (K3, P1) repeat across row, ending with K3 Row 4: P1, (K3, P1) repeat across row Repeat these 4 rows.

When you are getting low on your last ball of yarn, measure off about 20 yards from the other end of the ball and make a little slip knot in the yarn. Continue in pattern until you get to the slip knot, then begin ribbing the same as in the beginning (for about 17 rows) and then bind off in ribbing. Wash your beautiful new scarf in cold water and a nice wool wash like

Eucalan, squeeze gently, then roll in a towel to get out excess water. Lay out to dry!





ABBREVIATIONS:

K=Knit P=Purl K2tog= Knit 2 together PM= Place marker Kf&b= Increase by knitting into the front & back of stitch.
M1= Make 1 stitch by inserting left needle under the bar in between stitches from front to back and then knit the lifted strand through the back to twist it as you make a stitch. (You can also insert needle from back to front and knit into the front)
SSK= Slip 2 sts, one at a time as if to knit. Insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts from left to right and K2tog in this position.
Y/O= yarn over (bring yarn in between and then over right hand needle)
