

Size: Pattern makes a cowl that will easily wrap double. Approximately 7" wide, 21" across (42" circumference)

Materials: Two skeins of Classic Elite Palace, 50g/98yards. Circular needle size 11, 24" or 32" long.

<u>Gauge:</u> Approximately 3 stitches = 1'' in seed stitch.



Directions:

Cast on 121 stitches. Place marker and join, being careful not to twist. Begin seed stitch:

Row 1: *K1, P1, repeat from *

Row 2: *P1, K1, repeat from *

NOTE: Once you get done with the first round, you will notice that there is no real break in the K1, P1 pattern. So, you really don't have to keep a marker in, you can just knit every purl stitch and purl every knit stitch and you will stay in pattern, and don't worry about where the end of the round is!

When you get most of the way through your second skein of yarn, unroll it and measure off 7-8 yards from the other end. Make a slip knot or put a safety pin at this point. Roll your yarn back up again and keep going in seed stitch until you get to the marked spot, then bind off in seed stitch.

Wash your lovely new neckwear in cold water and a gentle woolwash like Eucalan, roll in a towel to remove excess water, and lay flat to dry.

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
